## IV. What c umulative assessments will I take this year?

## 1. Quarter Tests

- The quarter test counts as 1 test grade
- The quartertest may also be used to replace a low grade from the quarter


## 2. Midterm

- Cumulative NYS exam - consists of all topics ta ught during quarters 1 - 4
- Accounts for $20 \%$ of the $4^{\text {th }}$ quarter average
- May also be used to replace a low grade from the quarter
- Grade appears on high school transcript


## V. How is homework graded?



1. Checked daily by your teacherfor 5 points

- HW must be complete and all work must be shown to receive full credit


## VI. How is my grade calculated?

- $1^{\text {st }}$ a nd $3^{\text {rd }}$ Quarters $=90 \%($ Avg. of Tests \& Quizzes) $+10 \%(H W)$
- $2^{\text {nd }}$ Q uarter $=20 \%($ Midterm) $+70 \%($ Avg. of Tests \& Q uizzes) $+10 \%(H W)$
- $4^{\text {th }}$ Quarter $=20 \%$ (Regents) $+70 \%($ Avg. of Tests \& Quizzes) $+10 \%(H W)$
