## I. What supplies should I have with me every day?

- Binder
- Pencils/pens
- Loose-leaf
- Graph paper

- Straight edge
- Graphing calculator - provided by the Roslyn School District
*You are responsible to replace a lost or damaged calculator*
Always come prepared to class - you will not be allowed to return to your locker once the bell has rung.


## II. How should I organize my notebook?

Create 3 sections:

1. Notes/HW Section
2. Test/Quiz Section
3. RPS Section (Regents Prep Section)


If you are absent, it is YOUR responsibility to get the notes, homework and other assigned work that you missed from rmsalgebra.weebly.com.

## III. What types of assessments will I take?

1. Tests

- Full period assessment (counts 3 times)
- At least one week's notice will be given

- Review sheet will be provided prior to the exam for the first two quarters
- The Research Paper grade will count as a test during the $2^{\text {nd }}$ quarter
- See the calendar page on rmsalgebra.weebly.com for assessment dates

2. Quizzes

- Not a full period assessment (counts 1 time)
- 1-2 days' notice will be given
- All take home assessments count as quizzes

If absent on the day of an exam, be prepared to take the exam upon returning to school.

## IV. What cumulative assessments will I take this year?

## 1. Quarter Tests

- Given at the end of the $1^{\text {st }}$ and 3 rd $q u a r t e r s$
- Cumulative exam - consists of all topics taught during the quarter
- The quarter test counts as 1 test grade
- The quarter test may also be used to replace a low grade from the quarter


## 2. Midterm

- Given at the end of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Quarter
- Cumulative exam - consists of all topics taught during quarters 1 \& 2
- Accounts for $20 \%$ of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ quarter average
- May also be used to replace a low grade from the quarter


## 3. Regents

- Given at the end of the $4^{\text {th }}$ quarter
- Cumulative NYS exam - consists of all topics taught during quarters 1 - 4
- Accounts for $20 \%$ of the $4^{\text {th }}$ quarter average
- May also be used to replace a low grade from the quarter
- Grade appears on high school transcript


## V. How is homework graded?

1. Checked daily by your teacher for 5 points


- HW must be complete and all work must be shown to receive full credit


## VI. How is my grade calculated?

- $1^{\text {st }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ Quarters $=90 \%$ (Avg. of Tests \& Quizzes) $+10 \%(H W)$
- $2^{\text {nd }}$ Quarter $=20 \%$ (Midterm) $+70 \%$ (Avg. of Tests \& Quizzes) + 10\%(HW)
- $4^{\text {th }}$ Quarter $=20 \%$ (Regents) $+70 \%($ Avg. of Tests \& Quizzes) $+10 \%(H W)$
- Course Grade = (Q1 + Q2 + Q3 + Q4)/4
